

Your Child's Learning:

In English this half term the children will be learning to:

- Read and write non-chronological reports (see example attached)
- Write a description of a planet using adjectives and expanded noun phrases.

Read with your child at least 3 times a week.
Write a comment in the diary so dojo points can be rewarded.

To practise phonics and spellings, your child will be receiving weekly homework. Remember to access Bugclub for exciting books (login to follow).

In maths this half term the children will be learning:

- How to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and use these facts to solve problems.
- Understanding and using Place Value of up to 20 for Year and up to 100 for year 2.
- About the different ways of representing a number, for example:

$$37 = 30 + 7 \quad 37 = 20 + 17 \quad 37 = 17 + 10 + 10$$

Additionally, during the half term your child needs to choose and complete at least 2 of the following tasks.
