

Weekly Activities

In Literacy this term the children will be learning to:

- Read and write words in ways which match their spoken sounds.
- Read and write some irregular common words.
- Read and write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others.

In maths this term the children will be learning to:

- Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20 placing them in order
- say which number is one more or one less than a given number.
- add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.
- solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.
